

Small Enhancements, Big Improvements

Ergonomic Evaluations

Level 1: "Mini Evaluations": These evaluations are an economical, concise, yet effective approach to controlling workplace-related MSDs (musculoskeletal disorders). Our trained ergonomists spend 20 minutes with each employee and make "on the spot" recommendations. These evaluations are best suited to symptom-free workers and those considered at low MSD risk. They also are useful when upgrading office equipment, renovating workspaces, or as part of a new hire program.

Level 2: Protective Evaluations and Level 3: Post-Injury Evaluations: Level 2 and 3 evaluations are much more comprehensive in nature than Level 1 evaluations. Lasting 45 minutes apiece, these evaluations are ideal for workers with MSD symptoms or a physician referral, or those who work in high-risk jobs such as data entry and materials handling. As part of the Level 2 and 3 evaluation process, Ergo Concepts will provide a detailed report of overall ergonomic conditions within workstations and work areas.

Level 4: Follow-Up Evaluations: These visits are designed to ensure workstation recommendations and equipment modifications have been implemented properly. Individuals who received either a mini or formal evaluation in the past will be re-visited by an ergonomist. The visit will last 10-15 minutes and will answer questions and re-educate on the proper positioning and adjustment features of the new equipment. A short questionnaire will be administered to indicate if any further action is required. A copy will be provided to attach to the initial evaluation.

Photo Evaluations: These evaluations are designed for employees in remote locations, overseas or otherwise unavailable for an in-person assessment. The employee is asked to provide digital photographs of themselves at their workstation via email. A representative from Ergo Concepts will set up a phone interview at a mutually agreed upon time. Level 1-4 evaluations may be conducted as a photo evaluation. The written recommendations provided along with the images in the summary report correlate with the level of evaluation. Please see descriptions of evaluations above.
